Qualifications

Relevant qualifications is advantageous, however training will be provided for these roles, and includes holding a current First Aid Certificate, obtaining a PLPC (Pool Lifeguard practising Certificate) which is a requirement for the roles. The PLPC qualification requires attendance to trainings which is unpaid, and also 20 hours of unpaid shadowing to gain the required qualification needed to undertake the duties for the role. PLPC also requires that you pass the swim test, and other practical tasks that are required for the role. Any further trainings and staff meetings are paid.
